

## **Moshe Mittelman MD**

Moshe Mittelman serves as Chairman, the Department of Medicine and a Hematology Consultant at the Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center (TASMC), and Professor of Medicine at Sackler School of Medicine (SSM), Tel Aviv University (TAU). He is also the Director of The MDS Center of Excellence, at TASMC.

Dr. Mittelman graduated from the SSM in 1976, and served in the Israel Medical Corps (IDF), before completing residency. He later undertook a combined clinical and research fellowship in hematology-oncology at the George Washington University Medical Center, Washington DC, and the National Institutes of Health (NIH), USA. He returned to Israel in 1989 and has since held several clinical, academic and public posts. He served as President of the Israel Society of Internal Medicine, Secretary of the Israel Society of Hematology and is currently the President of the Israel Society of Hematology and Transfusion Medicine. Prof. Mittelman also serves as a Hematology consultant for the Israel Ministry of Health.

Among other duties, Dr. Mittelman served as member of the National Committee for New Technologies, and a member of the Israel Medical Association Scientific Committee. As the chairman of the Student Admissions Committee of the TAU SSM, Dr. Mittelman initiated and led the novel admission program. He has also served as a member of the National Council for Cancer and a member of the Board of Directors of the Israel Cancer Association. He is involved in biotechnology, both as an inventor (patents, founder of start-up companies), as well as a consultant for biotechnology firms.

Professor Mittelman's academic research interests include basic and clinical aspects of bone marrow stem cell disorders, such as myelodysplastic (and myeloproliferative) syndromes, multiple myeloma and erythropoietin. He founded the Israel MDS working group, and serves as a member of the executive and steering committees of the European MDS Group (EUMDS). He has presented more than 200 abstracts in international meetings, co-authored more than 200 scientific-medical publications, including textbook chapters and articles that have been published in journals such as Blood, Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, British Journal of Haematology, Leukemia Research, Journal of Clinical Oncology, Haematologica and Experimental Hematology.
